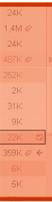
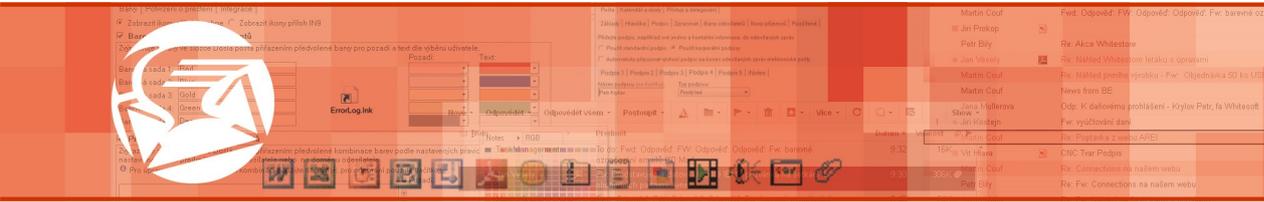

Introduction

SuperMail is a set of complementary functions extending logic of standard E-Mail Template of HCL Notes R7/R8/R8.5/R9. Any combination of functions can be chosen to fulfil your requirements.

Particular functions definition

1. Multiple signatures

Up to five different signatures can be created and marked by short title. Signatures can appear in the form of plain text or in HTML/Rich text format (incl. company logo etc.). Just one click to insert signatures to an E-mail.

User can also set a warning message notifying him of missing signature at the moment an E-mail is sent. This function can be disabled in case that an E-mail is sent to the sender domain (in case of a reply).

Tip: Many more options regarding E-mail signatures are offered by Corporate Signatures application.

2. Quick access to attachments

Attachments can be opened and saved without necessity of finding files in the E-mail body. Names of all E-mail attachments are displayed in the preview panel.

Just one click to open the attachment directly in associated application. (e.g. *.doc in MS Word) or click on “next” button to select one or more attachments from dialog box and saved them.

3. Attachment icons by type

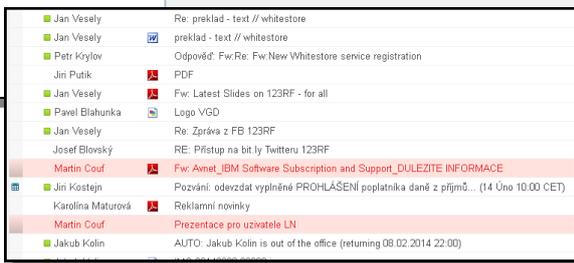
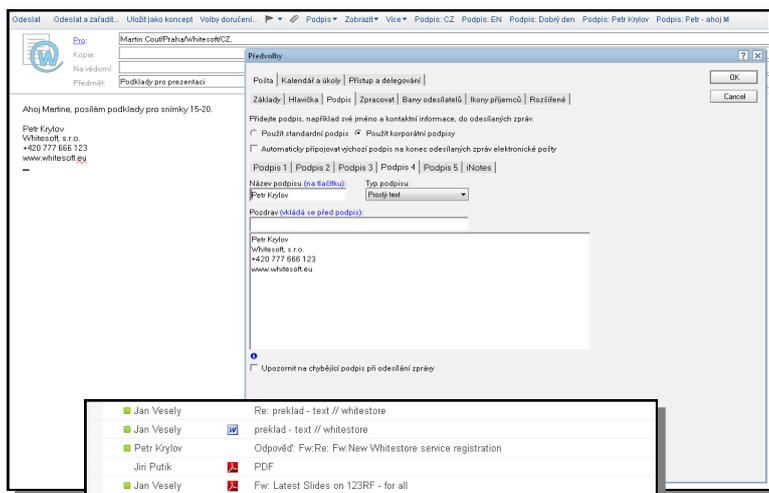
Attachment icons in all previews enable quick distinction of document based on type of the first attachment.

4. Adding a link to a shared file

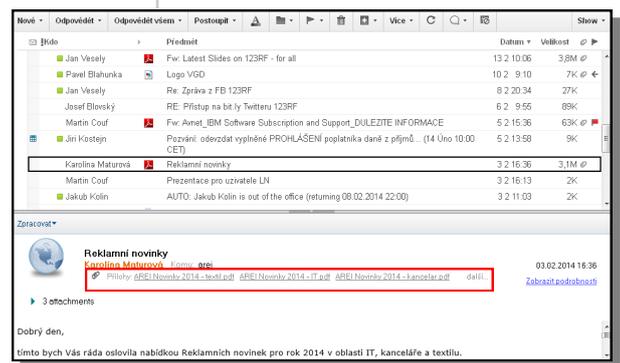
User has the possibility to insert a link (shortcut) to a shared file to the body of a message.



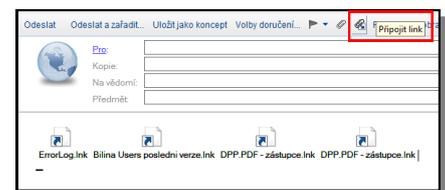
Multiple signatures setup



Attachment icons by type



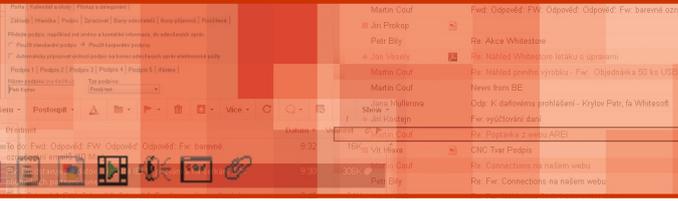

5. One button download of selected attachments

If an E-mail contains more attachments which can be located at various places in the text, the user can view a complete list of them and download the selected ones.

6. Mail highlighting advanced options

Messages can be highlighted for your letter orientation. There are two ways:

User highlighting - one or more messages marked by the user can easily be highlighted in accordance with user preferences. This can be done by clicking button in the settings bar where the user chooses one of five color combination (text, background).

Predefined highlighting - Messages can be highlighted by sender, subject or domain. Criteria are combinable; it means that user can decide whether it is sufficient for the message to fulfill one criterion or all at once to be highlighted. It is possible to define up to three colour combinations.

7. "Out of office" as a calendar entry

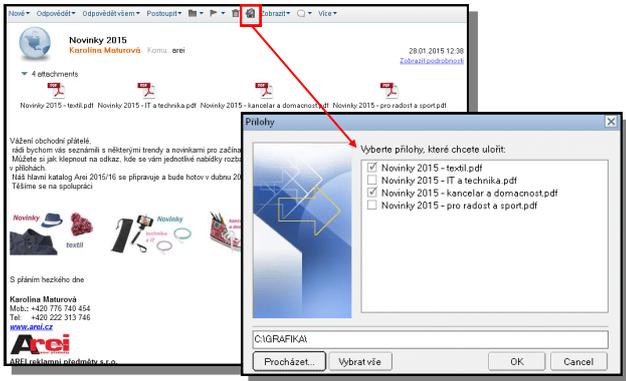
When the user sets the "Out of office" function, he can automatically create a calendar entry for the time he is out of office.

8. Attachments in EML format

One or more selected messages in EML format can be attached to an E-mail.

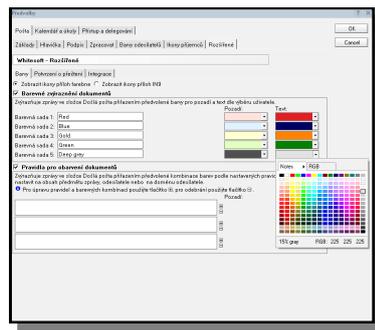
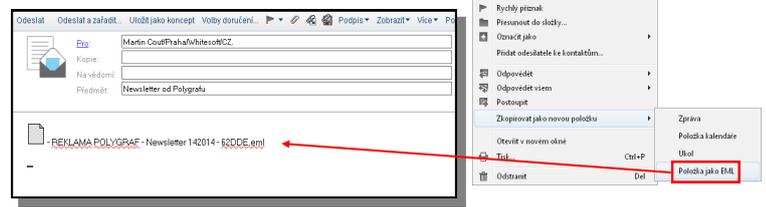
9. Ignoring prefixes when sorting E-mails

All the standardly used prefixes including foreign language variants (eg. Re:, Fw:, AW:, WG:, Ans:, ...) are ignored when sorting messages by subject. Messages are then correctly sorted by their subject and not by prefix.

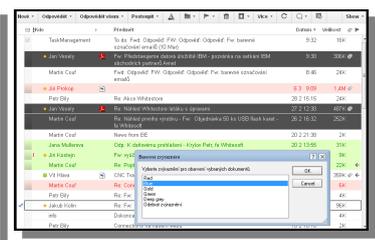

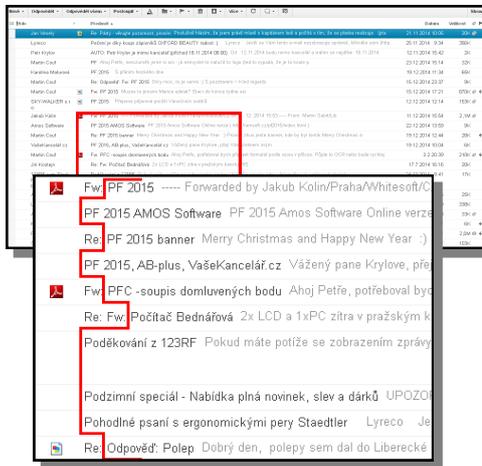
Attachments in EML format



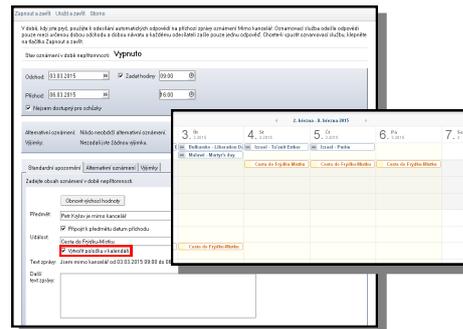
User highlighting



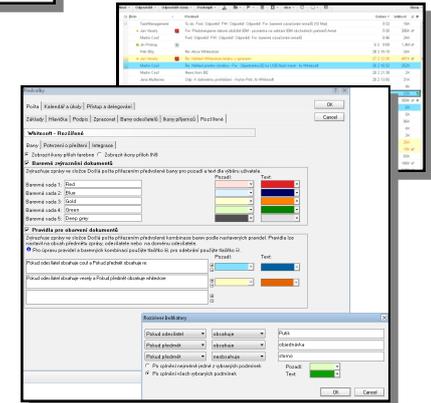
Predefined highlighting
